Collaboration and Partnerships

To formalize and guide these collaborations and partnerships, the institution relies on Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs). These MOUs outline the terms, objectives, and responsibilities of each party involved, providing a clear and binding framework for cooperation, and ensuring that all partnerships are conducted in a transparent and accountable manner.
